


The annual Zakir Husain Memorial Lecture honours an eminent educationist, nationalist and a very distinguished former President of India, Dr. Zakir Husain. The lecture series also constitutes a significant tribute to an institution of higher education that has retained a sense of enduring identity over three centuries. Established as the Madrasa Ghaziuddin in the closing years of the reign of Emperor Aurangzeb, it has repeatedly transformed itself in response to the challenges with which it was confronted, over a long and turbulent period of India's history. For this reason, its fortunes seem inextricably linked to the fortunes of the country and Delhi, its premier city.

Instituted more than three decades back, Zakir Husain Memorial Lectures have been delivered by distinguished scholars, who have engaged with critical issues that are at the heart of contemporary life.

Professor Faizan Mustafa, Vice-Chancellor of NALSAR University of Law, Hyderabad, is one of the most distinguished and internationally acclaimed legal scholars of India. Recipient of Commonwealth Scholarship as well as Fulbright Fellowship, Professor Mustafa was conferred the SAARC Best Law Teacher award in 2014. He was the President and Vice-President of the prestigious Shastri Indo-Canadian Institute. Professor Mustafa is the Founder Vice-Chancellor of National Law University, Orissa and advisor to the National Law School and Judicial Academy, Assam. Known for his institution building abilities and democratic leadership, Professor Mustafa is the visiting faculty to many institutions in India and abroad. He is the founder director of KIIT Law School, Bhubaneshwar and Dean faculty of Law and Registrar, Aligarh Muslim University. Professor Mustafa is the author of eight books and has contributed more than 400 articles. The Supreme Court of India has quoted him several times. In the Sabarimala judgement, his research paper was cited. Professor Mustafa writes regularly in leading newspapers and magazines on current legal issues and also runs a popular YouTube channel namely, "Legal Awareness Web Series".
