Safety and Security



The college has a total of 15 security staff. Students' entry is strictly on the basis of college ID card. Visitors are allowed on the basis of a pass at the main gate and their entry is recorded in a register.

The collegehas 73 CCTV cameras installed covering the entire campus including outdoor and indoor areas.

Counselling and Medical Facility



The College has a medico-counselling room adjacent to the college library with first aid facilities. A Counselling Psychologist is available in the college on daily basis for counselling of the students/staff.

We have appointed a Gynaecologist for the benefit of girl students/staff and a General Practitioner also visits the college on alternative days for medical consultation.

During the COVID-19 pandemic a

Teachers Counselling Team was constituted to counsel the students in the situation of stress and depression. Students could share their problems with them freely.

There is an ICC (Internal Complaints Committee) for investigating any complaint of sexual harassment from any woman student or teaching / non-teaching staff. Time to time this committee organises various programme to sensitize students.

The college also has Girls Association and Women Development Cell to organize various events related to gender equity issues.

The college has a Gender Sensitizing Committee that organises activities throughout the year to sensitise students on gender related issues.

We also have a Student Grievance Redressal Committee as per UGC Regulations, 2019.

Girls Common Room



To facilitate female students, the college has Girls Common Room with good seating arrangement and ambience along with Washroom, Female attendant, Sanitary Napkin Vending Machine, magazines and newspaper facilities. There is provision for indoor games such as Table tennis, Carrom and Chess.

Tailoring Facility



A Vocational training is given to the girls' students in the tailoring section of the college by trained staff. No fees is charged from the students.
