


GLIMPSES FOR NEW INITIATIVES 2023-24

Our country has a long history, from Bharath to Bharat. In this series, one of the figures is Rani Durgavati born in 1524 in the Gond dynasty, the courageous queen of Gondwana, is a testament to the indomitable spirit and courage that characterized many historical figures in India. Rani Durgavati's sacrifice became legendary, immortalizing her as a symbol of resistance and fortitude. The queen's commitment to her subjects, her fearlessness in the face of adversity, and her willingness to make the ultimate sacrifice have made her a revered figure in Indian folklore. Beyond her military prowess, Rani Durgavati was also known for her commitment to the welfare of her people. Her rule saw the promotion of art, culture, and economic prosperity in Gondwana. In conclusion, she was known for her bravery, leadership, and sacrifice. Her legacy is a beacon of inspiration, reminding us of the strength within individuals willing to stand up for their principles, even in the face of seemingly insurmountable odds.

Dashrath Manjhi, born in 1934 in the Gehlour village of Bihar also known as the "Mountain Man" of India, was a remarkable individual whose extraordinary feat of determination and perseverance has left an indelible mark on the landscape of Bihar. Dashrath's wife, Falguni Devi, fell severely ill, and in the absence of a proper road, Dashrath's wife succumbed to her illness, leaving him grief-stricken and determined to prevent such a tragedy from befalling others in his village. Dashrath Manjhi took it upon himself to carve a path through the formidable Gehlour hills. This mammoth task seemed impossible to many and took Dashrath 22 years to complete. In 1982, after more than two decades of backbreaking labor, Dashrath Manjhi succeeded in his monumental task. The 360-foot-long and 25-foot-wide road he carved through the hills transformed the lives of the villagers. In recognition of his extraordinary efforts, his story has been featured in documentaries and films. He passed away in 2007, but his legacy inspires generations, reminding us that even the most daunting obstacles can be overcome through unwavering determination and relentless effort.



Dr. Janaki Ammal, born on November 4, 1897, in Tellicherry (now Thalassery), Kerala, India, (1897–1984) was a distinguished Indian botanist and cytogeneticist known for pioneering plant genetics and cytogenetics contributions. Janaki Ammal earned her Bachelor of Science from Queen Mary's College in Chennai and later pursued higher education in the United States. She obtained her D.Sc. in 1931 from the University of Michigan, becoming one of the first Indian women to earn a doctorate in science from an American university. She made groundbreaking contributions to understanding the genetics of sugarcane, brinjal (eggplant), and other economically important plants. Dr. Janaki Ammal held served as the Director-General of the Botanical Survey of India. She also worked at the John Innes Horticultural Institution in the United Kingdom. In recognition of her contributions, she was honored the Padma Shri.



We celebrate September 05 as Teachers' Day each year. On this occasion, Master Ramchandra Park (मा. रामचन्द्र उद्यान) in memory of Master Ramchandra, one of the leading academic lights from the great history of the Zakir Husain Delhi College. Master Ramchandra was a renowned mathematician and an Urdu stylist. As a mathematician, he is known for his contributions to prime number theory and transcendental number theory. As a renowned academician, he translated several mathematics textbooks and works of literature into Urdu. He was a regular contributor and founder of some of the leading journals of the time that aimed to spread modern education and thoughts beyond the college's boundary into the walled city.



A comprehensive 40-hour certificate course on the Basics of Machine Learning was launched on 18th March 2024 for UG/PG students, Researcher scholars, and Faculties by coordinator Dr. Dhiraj Kumar Singh, Department of Mathematics, Zakir Husain Delhi College. This course was designed to provide participants with a solid understanding of essential concepts, hands-on experience, and the ability to apply machine-learning techniques to real-world scenarios. Introduction to Machine Learning, Fundamentals of Data and Statistics, Supervised Learning, Unsupervised Learning, Model Evaluation and Hyperparameter Tuning, Introduction to Machine Learning Libraries and Applications are key topics of the course. Prof. Shikha Mehta, the Department of Computer Science Engineering at Jaypee Institute of Information Technology, Noida; Dr. Sanjay Yadav, University of People, United States; Dr. Pravesh Kumar, Department of Mathematics, Rajkiya Engineering College, Bijnor were course experts; and Dr. Vikas Mittal, School of Computer and Systems Sciences, Jawaharlal Nehru University were the course experts.

Western Music Society, ILLUME


Illume comprises of young and upcoming musicians who have been working together towards refining their skills and creating original music. The society also performs at the

The Botany department at Zakir Husain Delhi College organized a series of educational activities aimed at enriching students' understanding of various aspects of botany and related fields. An educational excursion from October 15-19, 2023, took second-year Botany Honors students to Mukteshwar and Nainital in Uttarakhand. Led by Dr. Malti Gupta and Dr. Ruchi Vir, students explored local flora and visited institutes like IVRI, CITH, TERI Himalayan Centre, and ARIES, gaining insights into ecosystem studies and future career paths. A visit to Aravalli Biodiversity Park on February 9, 2024, allowed students to study ecology and environmental factors, contributing to biodiversity conservation awareness and enhancing their understanding of ecological processes. On March 16, 2024, a field trip along the Yamuna River enabled students to collect and analyze algal and water samples, enhancing their practical knowledge in botany. Collaborating with FSSAI, the department organized a food safety training program on October 17, 2024, sensitizing students and faculty about food adulteration, especially during festivals like Deepawali. A visit to the BioNEST facility on February 22, 2024, exposed final-year Botany (Hons) students to microbial technology and advanced fermentation techniques, providing hands-on experience in this field. Additionally, on February 28, 2024, students and faculty were invited to NII as part of the DBT-NII Science Setu Outreach Program, where they attended seminars, participated in quizzes, and engaged in poster presentations, contributing to their exposure to cutting-edge research.

Commerce Society


