The Society started its activities with a presentation on the eve of Independence Day. Our students also had the honour to be invited to perform in the inaugural programme of *Antardhwani* – the first cultural festival of University of Delhi. We are proud to report that many of our talented students participated and won prizes in different inter-college and inter-university programmes.
