






Figure 8.1 Diagrammatic representation of the female reproductive system in humans

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7Mass Spectrometry

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7.1 PRINCIPLE

Mass spectrometry (MS) is the most versatile and powerful analytical technique used in various fields of science, such as biology, chemistry, physics, clinical medicine and space research. The technique is based upon the principle of ion formation from an analyte in its gaseous form by any suitable method followed by their separation according to their masses (more precisely according to their mass-to-charge ratio) and finally measurement of their relative abundance to provide qualitative and quantitative information about the analyte. Sorting of ions, according to their mass-to-charge ratio is achieved by combining electrical and magnetic fields. It is a destructive technique in which sample is consumed during analysis. Unlike other spectroscopic techniques mass spectrometry does not require absorption or emission of electromagnetic radiations.

7.2 HISTORY

In the mid-19th century, the research studies in the field of physics laid the foundation stone for the development of mass spectrometry and it actually began with the introduction of positive ray analyser by British physicist Sir J. J. Thomson, who had already been awarded the Nobel prize of physics in 1906 for his contribution in theoretical and experimental investigations on the conduction of electricity by gas. With this apparatus in 1912, Thomson successfully obtained the first mass spectrum of various low molecular weight substances. This development prompted the study of isotopes for the first time and showed the way forward for the development of mass

INTRODUCTION

While one of the characteristics of postcolonial Indian SF is its involvement with and reworking, as it were, of its history; another, in opposition to the first one, is the imagining of a future through that history. What is interesting to note is that this future, more often than not, working through the present Indian sociopolitical and existential contexts, is a dystopia where governments, capitalist conglomerates, ecological destructions and/or unchecked adherence to structures of dominance, whether political, religious or social, have destroyed any hope of founding a long-lasting successful 'modern' nation. While, in its earlier characteristic deployment, postcolonial Indian SF manages to step outside the controlling discursivities of the West, in its second avatar (here second has been used merely in a relational way), it shows how the promises offered by the freedom from its colonial past have been, in the wake of unmitigated human folly, completely squandered. Decolonisation of the Indian past, after all, does not guarantee a different present or a better future.

Indrani Das Gupta and Shraddha A. Singh's paper reads Rimi B. Chatterjee's novella 'Arisudan' as a representative narrative of this second form of postcolonial Indian SF to show how the Indian nation, despite the possibilities presented by a decolonised past, fails to live up to the ostensible freedom. They show how Chatterjee's novella, through the presentation of this dystopic future, comments on not only the failures of the Indian nation in its governmental capacities but also its social and ecological ones. Doom, in a sense, will strike the nation from all fronts if present methods of existential interactions are not modified.

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Affective Witnessing: Testimony in the Age of Post-truth

Abstract

An interesting phenomenon of post truth moment is the rise of personal testimony and witnessing cultures. Informed by theories of affect, this paper examines how affective witnessing has emerged as a powerful tool in a highly mediatized and networked world by focusing on #MeToo movement and #NotInMyName protest as they unfolded on social media and moved from digital to the real world. Focusing on how affect constitutes witnessing as a collective and relational practice, with the effect of forming communities and provoking further testimonies, the paper argues that 'affective economies' (Ahmed 2004) of contemporary media landscape create feelings of communality and solidarity and reimagines new ways of being ethical and political. In foregrounding witnessing as a way of affecting and being affected, the paper draws attention to the challenges of contesting 'truth' claims, 'alternative facts', and competing witnesses, each claiming its own veracity with great vigour. The paper reflects on the paradox of the post truth moment which is marked by significant ethical quandaries that arise as we engage with mediatized witnessing in the digital age.

The significance of testimony and bearing witness is inextricably linked to the issues of epistemic injustice and violence in contemporary times. Whether it is witnessing from the site of historical trauma as in Holocaust and Partition, testifying before Truth and Reconciliation in conflict zones as part of transitional justice, denouncing human rights violations in testimonio, testimony finds a place in the context of denial, oppression, violence where the victim or the survivor in the act of giving testimony recounts personal and collective oppression. Bearing witness to trauma has been institutionalized as a way of moving forward after genocide and human rights violations and this has given impetus to 'speaking out' against injustice, oppression, and violence.
