GLIMPSES FOR NEW INITIATIVES

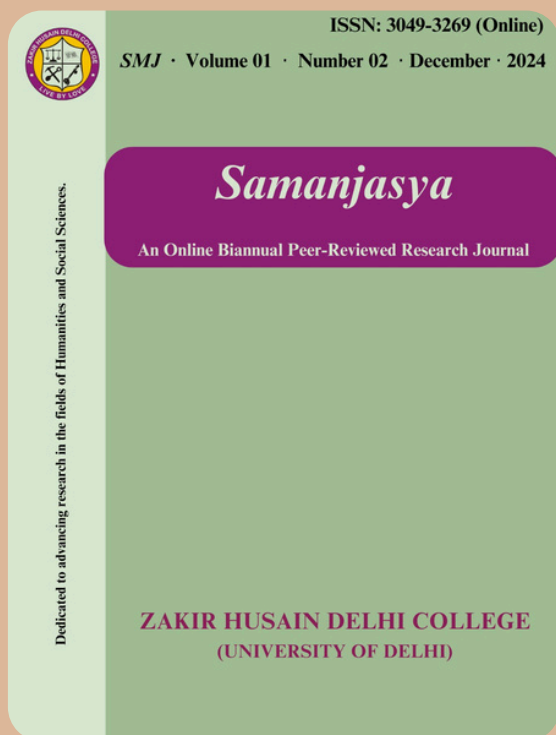

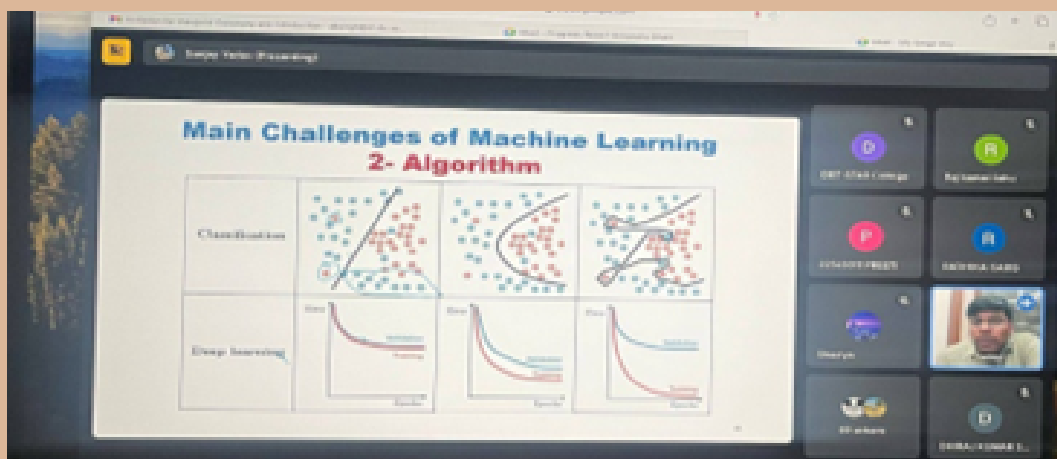
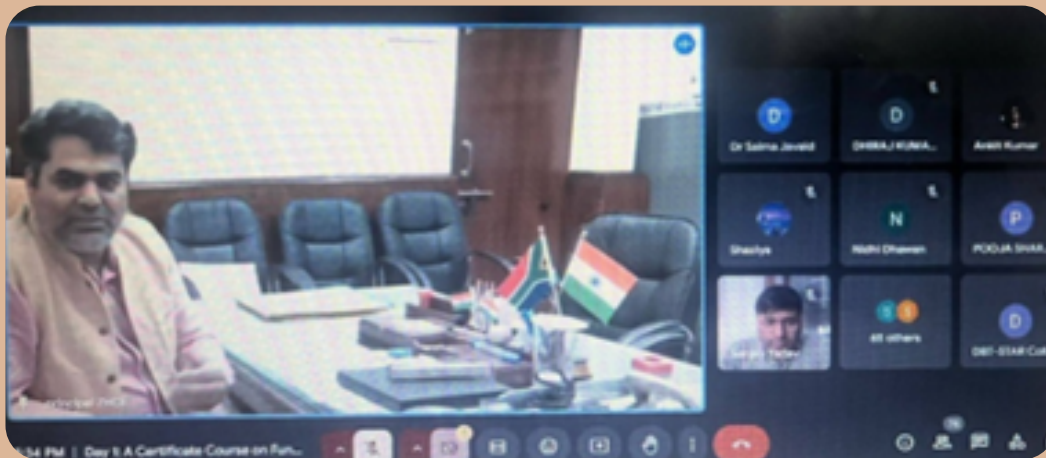

Optimization: Techniques for Efficient Learning”, a concise 10-hour module curated to introduce students to key optimization techniques in machine learning. The course, coordinated by Dr. Dhiraj Kumar Singh from the Department of Mathematics, served as an accessible starting point for those interested in AI, equipping them with the foundational tools to understand algorithmic efficiency and real-world applications.



The Skill Development and Learning Centre (SDLC) of Zakir Husain Delhi College, University of Delhi, launched a Certificate Course in Counselling Skills on March 7, 2025. Dr. Nisha Jaiswal, Department of Psychology, is the coordinator of the course. This course is aimed at developing essential counselling competencies such as active listening, empathy, effective communication, and ethical practices. It is particularly designed for students and professionals in fields like psychology, education, social work, and other areas that involve interpersonal support.



The Skill Development and Learning Centre (SDLC) of Zakir Husain Delhi College, University of Delhi, has launched a Certificate Course in R.O. Servicing and Assembly in collaboration with Samarth Bharat. This practical, skill-oriented program is designed to train participants in the servicing, maintenance, and assembly of Reverse Osmosis (R.O.) water purification systems. As the demand for clean water and purification technology continues to grow, this course aims to create employment and self-employment opportunities in the expanding water purification industry.

The course offers a hands-on learning experience, equipping participants with the technical knowledge and practical skills required for the installation and upkeep of R.O. systems. It brings together interdisciplinary expertise, with coordination by Mr. Abhinav Singh Katiyar (Department of Psychology), Dr. Manish Kumar (Department of Electronics), and Dr. Bhupender Kumar (Department of Commerce). Their combined efforts ensure a holistic training approach, integrating technical proficiency with entrepreneurial insight and community-oriented learning.



The Arts and Culture Society (Suchitra- Fine Arts Society) of Zakir Husain Delhi College in collaboration with UDAAN, organized the Valedictory Ceremony for 15-day Painting Workshop focused on Indian Scientists and their Contributions to Science and Technology on 3rd March 2025. The workshop was a great success, and the final exhibition of paintings was unveiled during the ceremony.

On 1st October, 2024, students of the society were invited to Ramjas college to celebrate Tagore's "Home and the World" that was honoured with songs and recitations of Tagore.

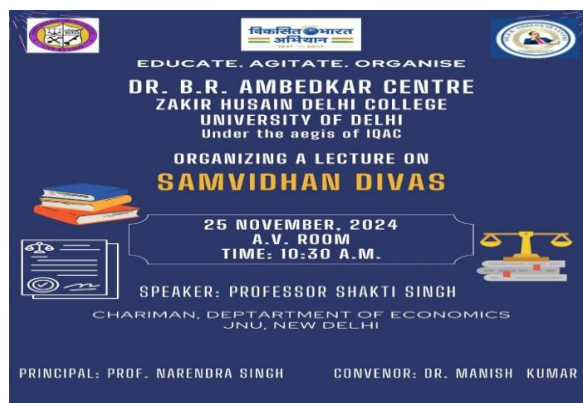
The Botanical Society-Nargis **Convenor: Dr. Ruchi Vir**

Career Counselling and Placement Cell

The Career Counselling and Placement Cell of Zakir Husain Delhi College, University of Delhi, had a productive and engaging academic year 2024–2025, marked by a range of seminars, workshops, and the successful organization of its annual job and internship fair, VRITI'25. These initiatives were designed to enhance students' employability, communication skills, and real-world readiness.

The year began with a seminar on **“Public Speaking and Case Study”** on October 18, 2024, conducted by Mr. Amit Poddar, Senior Regional Head at T.I.M.E. Mr. Poddar shared his insights on effective public speaking, confidence-building, and interview performance. He introduced the S.P.E.L.T. framework (Social, Political, Economic, Legal, and Technological analysis) to help students structure their responses during interviews. The session also covered case study analysis, encouraging students to think critically, collaborate on problem-solving, and apply practical frameworks in real-world business scenarios.

On February 21, 2025, a seminar on **“Logical Reasoning for MBA Entrance Exams”** was held, featuring Mr. Navneet Anand, Business Head at Career Launcher, Delhi. The session highlighted the importance of logical and critical reasoning for both competitive exams and corporate life. Using interactive exercises and real-world analogies, Mr. Anand demonstrated how reasoning and decision-making play a crucial role in interviews, corporate strategy, and everyday problem-solving.

The Cell also organized a session on **“Digital Marketing”** on February 27, 2025, led by Mr. Ayush Tandon, a digital marketing expert with vast experience in social media strategy and online branding. He introduced students to essential concepts such as content creation, SEO, inbound marketing, and platform-specific branding approaches. The session was interactive

and informative, offering practical insights into the growing digital economy and encouraging students to explore career options in this fast-evolving field.

Another key seminar, **“Let’s Crack an Interview,”** was conducted by Ms. Gazal Munjal from IMS Proschool on March 21, 2025. The session provided hands-on guidance on crafting effective resumes and cover letters, understanding interview dynamics, and presenting oneself confidently in front of recruiters. Special focus was given to ATS (Applicant Tracking System) compliance and differentiating between fresher and experienced interview approaches.

The highlight of the year was **VRITI’25 – the Annual Job and Internship Fair**, held on March 26, 2025. Ateera promotes sustainable livelihood through handcrafted, eco-conscious candles, including new variants such as coffee candles, beeswax products, and essential oil-infused designs. By offering skill training to women, Ateera has fostered both environmental awareness and economic empowerment. Qumash is a fashion-forward upcycling venture that repurposes discarded clothing into Gen Z-inspired apparel and lifestyle products. At the Diwali Fest held at Ramjas College on October 21, 2024, Enactus ZHDC showcased products from Kaagad, Ateera, and Qumash. Further, at the DU Literature Festival held at Sri Ram College of Commerce from February 21 to 23, 2025, the team engaged with an audience of over 1000 attendees, including renowned journalist Rajdeep Sardesai, effectively amplifying the reach and impact of their mission. On 14th September 2024, students explored Mehrauli Archaeological Park and the Qutub Minar, engaging with Delhi's medieval and Sultanate-era history through monuments like the Tombs of Jamali Kamali and Rajon ki Baoli. Another captivating walk was organized on 5th October 2024 to Tughlaqabad Fort, followed by a guided tour of the National Museum, offering insights into Delhi's military architecture and India's rich cultural heritage. The Society also organized a departmental visit on 4th March 2025 to Amrit Udyan within the Rashtrapati Bhavan estate. On 20th September 2024, the Inter-College Quiz Competition held in the AV Room tested participants' knowledge across history, culture, and current affairs. The team from St. Stephen's College—Advait Mishra and Divyansh Shah—emerged victorious, with Hansraj College securing the runner-up position. On the following day, 21st September 2024, the Inter-College Paper Presentation Competition was organized in the Conference Hall, featuring participants from six colleges. The event, noted for its academic rigor and analytical depth, saw Advait Mishra (St. Stephen's College) winning the top prize, followed by Manas Goel (Atma Ram Sanatan Dharma College). Additionally, the Society organized an Inter-College Extempore Competition on 15th February 2025 around the theme "Viksit Bharat", encouraging students to articulate spontaneous and diverse visions of India's development. Aditi Dwivedi (Aurobindo College) won the competition, with Akanshya Mishra (Gargi College) as the runner-up. The Departmental Paper Presentation held on 21st September 2024, Mohammad Fareed winning first place and Jayraj Yadav as the runner-up. Library Committee

During the academic year 2024–25, Zakir Husain Delhi College Library continued to excel in providing quality services and resources. A total of 708 books were acquired and processed. The library subscribed to 23 newspapers and 6 magazines in multiple languages, including 3 Braille magazines for visually impaired users. Operating fully in automated mode using LibSys 10 ILMS since 2017, the library also ensures multilingual book entry in original scripts. Stock verification was completed with no loss reported due to strict access control. National Librarian's Day was celebrated on 12th August 2024 with a national-level quiz, attracting 217 participants. Additional highlights included a Book Exhibition on India's Independence and extensive outreach via digital platforms. The College Librarian and the library staff participated in national and international workshops, while monthly in-house training sessions were conducted for staff development and skill enhancement.

On July 23, 2024, IQAC and the Saksham Bhoomi Foundation held a tree plantation drive at Wazirabad Biodiversity Park. The society and Golden Hive Foundation held a Honeybee Workshop at Sunder Nursery on December 5, 2024. From February 3 to 10, 2025, the Society, IQAC, Bisleri, and KARO Sambhav Foundation held an E-Waste and Plastic Collection Drive. They stressed the importance of recycling e-waste and plastic to reduce pollution. The college collected 17.5 kg of e-waste, reducing CO₂ emissions by 35.6 kg. Department of Physics : Physical Science Society

Department of Political Science

It began its academic activities with the inaugural lecture on 'The People in the Indian Constitutionalism' by Prof. Mathew John on October 17, 2024. On November 18, 2024, another special lecture by Prof. Madhulika Banerjee on Indian Knowledge Systems was organized. On February 19, 2025, the 4th Dr. Om Prakash Memorial Lecture was delivered

by Prof. Niraja Gopal Jayal. An online interactive session with Prof. Pooran C. Pandey on the topic 'The Future of Peace and Democracy' was held on March 20, 2025. In collaboration with the Department of Political Science, University of Delhi, a talk on 'Democracy, Student Movements, and Regime Change in Bangladesh' was organized on September 20, 2024, and delivered by Ambassador Veena Sikri.

The Psychology Department: Psychedelics

On October 7, 2024, in recognition of World Mental Health Day, the department hosted various events. Ms. Kanika Khandelwal, Clinical Psychologist at the Institute of Human Behaviour and Allied Sciences (IHBAS) and an alumna of Zakir Husain Delhi College, delivered a talk on the topic "Mental Health among Youth: Harnessing Positivity for Greater Well-being". The department also organized a screening of Pixar's animated film 'Inside Out' in the AV Room of the Science Block. A Mental Health Drive titled "Know Yourself" was successfully conducted throughout the day. This student-led initiative aimed at spreading awareness and screening students, faculty, and staff members using psychometric tools such as the Rosenberg Self-Esteem Scale (RSE), the Positive and Negative Affect Schedule (PANAS), and the Patient Health Questionnaire-9 (PHQ-9). Tests were administered to approximately 100 individuals, ensuring a confidential and ethical assessment process. As an extension of the college's counseling cell, the department initiated a WhatsApp community channel, 'मनःस्थल', under the guidance of Dr. Ritu Aggarwal, Assistant Professor, Department of 98 Psychology. The channel publishes multiple posts regularly to educate the community on mental health. To help students gain valuable insights into postgraduate entrance exams and the relevance of the fourth-year undergraduate program, the department organized a seminar on February 8, 2025, titled "How to Prepare for CUET PG and Other Entrances in Psychology". The session was delivered by Mr. Amit Panwar, Founder Psychologist at Power Within Ltd. and an alumnus of the Department of Psychology, Zakir Husain Delhi College (Batch of 2016). The session focused on various career possibilities in higher education after undergraduate studies, including preparation tips for prospective fellowships like UGC-NETJRF, NFOBC and more. The Department of Psychology, in collaboration with the Skill Development and Learning Centre (SDLC), inaugurated a Certificate Course in Counselling Skills on March 7, 2025, featuring a keynote session on "Stress Management" by Prof. U.K. Sinha, the Head of Department of Clinical Psychology at IHBAS.

Skill Development & Learning Centre (SDLC)

The Skill Development & Learning Centre (SDLC) at Zakir Husain Delhi College (University of Delhi) continued its mission to empower students with essential vocational and professional skills through thoughtfully designed certificate courses and workshops. Emphasizing interdisciplinary collaboration, innovation, and practical learning, the Centre has emerged as a hub for nurturing future-ready talent.

One of the key highlights of this academic year was the launch of a Certificate Course in R.O. Servicing and Assembly on 18th November 2024 in collaboration with Samarth Bharat. This course aimed to provide students with hands-on training in water purification technologies, focusing on the assembly, maintenance, and servicing of Reverse Osmosis (R.O.) systems. The course was jointly coordinated by Mr. Abhinav Singh Katiyar (Department of Psychology), Dr. Manish Kumar (Department of Electronics), and Dr. Bhupender Kumar (Department of Commerce), bringing together expertise from diverse academic backgrounds to offer a holistic learning experience.

In response to the growing importance of artificial intelligence and data science, the SDLC also launched a Certificate Course titled “Fundamentals of A.I. Optimization: Techniques for Efficient Learning”, a concise 10-hour module curated to introduce students to key optimization techniques in machine learning, on 11th March 2025. The course, coordinated by Prof. Dhiraj Kumar Singh from the Department of Mathematics, served as an accessible starting point for those interested in AI, equipping them with the foundational tools to understand algorithmic efficiency and real-world applications. A total of 83 students from across India enrolled in the AI Optimisation Certificate Course, reflecting its national reach and growing interest in applied artificial intelligence.

The SDLC launched a Certificate Course in Counselling Skills on March 7, 2025. Dr. Nisha Jaiswal, Department of Psychology, is the coordinator of the course. This course is aimed at developing essential counselling competencies such as active listening, empathy, effective communication, and ethical practices. It is particularly designed for students and professionals in fields like psychology, education, social work, and other areas that involve interpersonal support. A total of 74 students from across India enrolled in the program, reflecting strong national interest in practical counselling training.

Adding to these impactful initiatives, the SDLC organized a one-day workshop titled “INNOQUEST: Design Thinking and Innovation” on 26th November 2024. The workshop featured esteemed speakers Prof. Ravinder Kaur and Prof. Naveen Rampal, who introduced students to the principles of design thinking and its relevance in creative problem-solving across disciplines. The session encouraged participants to adopt human-centered approaches, explore innovation in real-world contexts, and develop prototypes for social and entrepreneurial impact.

Throughout the year, the SDLC has continued to play a pivotal role in complementing formal education with practical, skill-based learning. With its multidisciplinary approach, dedicated faculty, and focus on emerging areas, the Centre has significantly contributed to enhancing

the employability and personal growth of the student community. Looking ahead, the SDLC aims to expand its offerings, forge new collaborations, and continue evolving as a cornerstone of professional development at Zakir Husain Delhi College.

Sports Advisory Committee

The newly renovated sports ground of Zakir Husain Delhi College was inaugurated on 22nd January 2025 by Prof. Balram Pani, Dean of Colleges, University of Delhi. In athletics, Himanshu Lohchab was a standout performer, winning three gold medals in long jump, triple jump, and 60m hurdles at the Dr. Bharat Ram Sports Meet. He also secured gold in long jump at FOYS (SRCC) and added further accolades at the Delhi University Inter-College competitions and Delhi State Athletics Championships. The college basketball team made significant appearances in numerous tournaments including the KMC Invitational, AGAAZ (Maitreyi College), Hobnob (JMC), and the prestigious YMCA Invitational. The team also competed in the DU Inter-College Tournament. Notably, one player won 2nd place at the Dball League, and another was awarded Best Defender at Bennett University. In chess, the team earned 4th position at Desportivos (LNMIT) and 6th at FOYS (SRCC). Individual team members also achieved ranks in national events, including 3rd place at Hourglass 4.0 and 7th place at Coherence Chess. The cricket team qualified for the semifinals in the Maharishi Premier League 2025 and reached the knockout stage in the Delhi University Inter-College Cricket Tournament. The football team also actively participated in major events such as Hobnob, Stricker's Cup, and the Dr. Bharat Ram Sports Meet, with one player securing 3rd position in the Inter-University Games (North West Zone) hosted by Pratap University. In judo, the college earned three bronze medals in different weight categories (under 57kg, 52kg, and 48kg) at the Dr. Bharat Ram Sports Meet. The kho-kho team maintained a strong presence by securing positions at FOYS (3rd), Athleema (5th), and Spardha (3rd).
